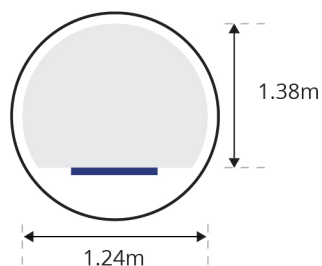
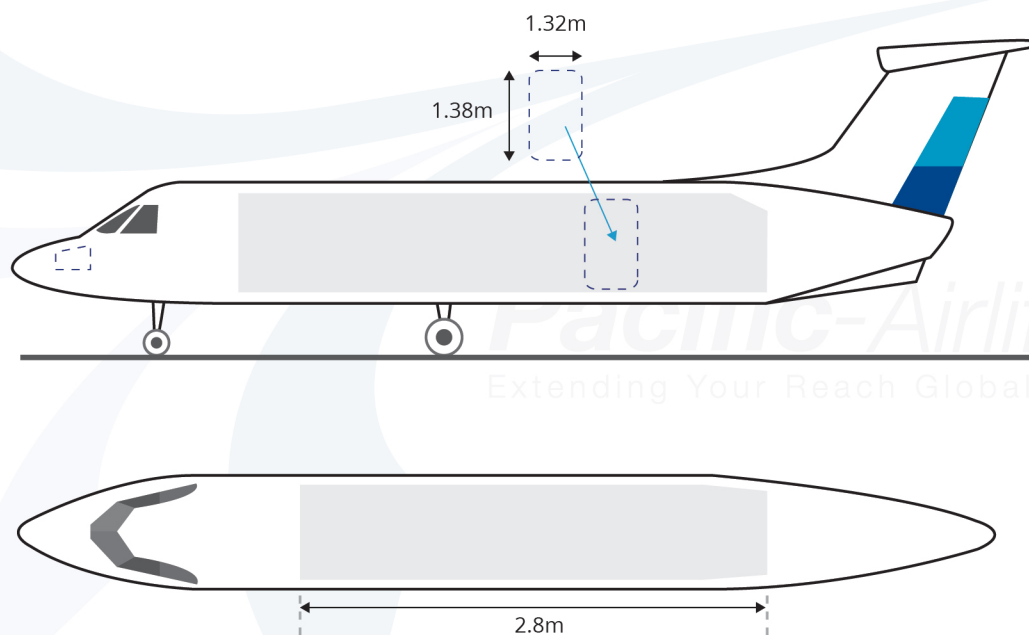




Beech King Air 200
